## Perspectives Included in the program...



### Real Australian stories

A 20 minute DVD containing real life stories of Australian people who have faced unplanned pregnancies.



### Fetal development models

Full scale models used to illustrate fetal development at different stages of pregnancy.



### Small group work

Small group discussions exploring issues raised in the DVD.



### Hands-on activities

Interactive activities to promote discussion and engagement of students.



### Take home journal and gift

A journal for each student to take home which includes links to resources and support networks.
